Kenseth on racing at Texas Motor Speedway: "I hope this weekend goes better than the spring race went. We struggled in April - there was a huge change in wind and temperature from practice to the race and we were behind all day. Things should be better Saturday. We only have a few races left to get back to victory lane and I know Eddie and these guys really want to end the year strong. The rest of the season we're going to some really good Roush Fenway tracks so I feel pretty good about our chances of winning. Our intermediate program is typically strong and the 16 guys won Phoenix earlier this year – I'm excited for the next three weeks, I think we'll be good."

Crew Chief Eddie Pardue on racing at Texas Motor Speedway: "The car we're taking to Texas is the same one that Biffle probably should've won Kansas with. It's definitely one of the best cars at the shop. I expect to run well this weekend – Texas has been a pretty good track for all of the Roush Fenway Nationwide Series teams. Horsepower is going to be real important this weekend and we've got the best engine tuners in the business over at the Roush Yates shop. We say this a lot, but I really feel good about this weekend and the rest of the season. They're great tracks for us and I'll be real disappointed if we don't win again."
