## Career Highlights

**2009:** Edwards achieved Sprint Cup Chase status for the fourth time in five years by finishing 11th in the overall series with seven top fives and 14 top 10s. He also finished second in the overall Nationwide Series standings. Statistically this was Edwards' best Nationwide Series result with five wins, 23 top-five and 30 top-10 finishes.

**2008:** Finished second overall in both the Sprint Cup and Nationwide Series standings. He had a phenomenal finale to 2008 in both series right down to the last races. Edwards finished his fourth full Sprint Cup season with nine wins, 19 top fives and 27 top 10s. In the Nationwide Series he had seven wins, 19 top fives and 22 top 10s.

**2007:** Edwards finished ninth in the overall Sprint Cup standings with one pole, three wins, 11 top-five and 15 top-10 finishes. He finished the 2007 Nationwide Series season with four wins, 15 top-five and 21 top-10 finishes. Edwards dominated the driver's points standings for 33 straight weeks on his way to winning his first NASCAR Nationwide Series Driver Championship title.

**2006:** Edwards struggled early in the Sprint Cup Series in 2006, but made a miraculous turn-around, finishing seven of the last 10 races in the top 10. He finished 12th in the overall standings. Edwards moved up one position from the previous year to second in the overall Nationwide Series standings. Edwards recorded a phenomenal record in 2006 with three poles, four wins, 15 top fives and 25 top 10s.

**2005:** Finished third in his first full season in both NASCAR's Sprint Cup & Nationwide Series. Captured first Sprint Cup and Nationwide Series wins back-to-back in Atlanta. Edwards compiled four wins, 13 top-five finishes and two poles in the Sprint Cup Series. He compiled five wins in the Nationwide Series, 15 top-five finishes and four poles. Won the Raybestos Rookie of the Year honors for the 2005 Nationwide Series.

**-FLASHBACK...**Last week at Michigan, Edwards finished 2nd after starting 14th. Edwards led a total of 19 laps.

**-CARL EDWARDS** will make his 13th Nationwide Series start at Bristol Motor Speedway Friday night. This is also his 200<sup>th</sup> career NASCAR Nationwide Series start.

**-FOR THE RECORD...** Edwards' average start at Bristol is 7.3 and his average finish is 11.6. Last year Edwards finished second in this summer night race and earlier this spring Edwards finished fourth at Bristol.

**-THE CAR...**The No. 60 Ford Mustang will carry the Fastenal colors this weekend.

**-THE CHASSIS...**The No. 60 team will unload chassis-RK 674. This is that same chassis that the team took to Dover and Bristol earlier this year, finishing respectively 11<sup>th</sup> and fourth.

**-ROUSH FENWAY RACING...**has five wins, 19 top-fives and 24 top-10 finishes in 52 NASCAR Nationwide Series starts at Bristol Motor Speedway.
