## Career Highlights

**2009:** Edwards achieved Sprint Cup Chase status for the fourth time in five years by finishing 11th in the overall series with seven top fives and 14 top 10s. He also finished second in the overall Nationwide Series standings. Statistically this was Edwards' best Nationwide Series result with five wins, 23 top-five and 30 top-10 finishes.

**2008:** Finished second overall in both the Sprint Cup and Nationwide Series standings. He had a phenomenal finale to 2008 in both series right down to the last races. Edwards finished his fourth full Sprint Cup season with nine wins, 19 top fives and 27 top 10s. In the Nationwide Series he had seven wins, 19 top fives and 22 top 10s.

**2007:** Edwards finished ninth in the overall Sprint Cup standings with one pole, three wins, 11 top-five and 15 top-10 finishes. He finished the 2007 Nationwide Series season with four wins, 15 top-five and 21 top-10 finishes. Edwards dominated the driver's points standings for 33 straight weeks on his way to winning his first NASCAR Nationwide Series Driver Championship title.

**2006:** Edwards struggled early in the Sprint Cup Series in 2006, but made a miraculous turn-around, finishing seven of the last 10 races in the top 10. He finished 12th in the overall standings. Edwards moved up one position from the previous year to second in the overall Nationwide Series standings. Edwards recorded a phenomenal record in 2006 with three poles, four wins, 15 top fives and 25 top 10s.

**2005:** Finished third in his first full season in both NASCAR's Sprint Cup & Nationwide Series. Captured first Sprint Cup and Nationwide Series wins back-to-back in Atlanta. Edwards compiled four wins, 13 top-five finishes and two poles in the Sprint Cup Series. He compiled five wins in the Nationwide Series, 15 top-five finishes and four poles. Won the Raybestos Rookie of the Year honors for the 2005 Nationwide Series.

**-CARL EDWARDS** will make his 11th Nationwide start at Daytona Saturday night. His best finish to date was second last year.

**-FOR THE RECORD...**Edwards' average start at Daytona International Speedway is 14.0, his average finish is 13.0. In ten starts at Daytona he's had four top five and six top ten finishes.

**-FLASHBACK...**Last year at Daytona, Edwards qualified 10<sup>th</sup>, finished second, and led 8 laps.

**-ON THE TRACK...**The No. 60 will carry the Fastenal colors Saturday, the first of 15 races for Fastenal as the primary sponsor.

**-Carl Edwards** and his wife Kate are expecting their first child this month.

**-400 WINS...** If Carl wins the Drive4COPD 300 Saturday it will mark Roush Fenway Racing's 400<sup>th</sup> win across all NASCAR and road racing series.

*"First race of the year, and I can't wait to get my No. 60 Fastenal/Copart Ford Fusion on the track at Daytona. It's going to be a great year and I am excited about our sixth full year in the Nationwide Series. The bottom line is to put our Ford in victory lane and win the championship. We have got a great time and we are ready to go!"*

### Crew Chief Mike Kelley Quote

*"Finally its here race season 2010, we are ready to get this underway. The 60 Fastenal team is excited and poised for a run at the championship. We plan on coming out of the box with a knockout punch. We are bringing the car we won Talladega last year and sat on the front row with in Daytona in July. It has been massaged and tweaked, polished and it is ready to hit the track. Our team knows what's on the line this season and everyone is all in. Being from Florida and that Daytona's one of our biggest races, it would mean so much to get back to Victory lane. I was fortunate to win a 500 down here, and it's a feeling you never forget. I'm hoping Carl and I can give that feeling to all the Fastenal and Roush Fenway group for the support they have given us in this quest for the 2010 Nationwide Championship."*
