Braun on racing at Kansas Speedway:

"I am really looking forward to getting back in the truck this weekend. I feel like it's been months since we've raced. Kansas is a great track and we finished third there last year so I'm hoping we can improve on that. I know two Roush Fenway drivers got their first wins in the truck series there so I'd really like to add my name to that list. The time we spent in Rockingham testing last week should help. We are getting back to basics with some of our set-up stuff, back to what the team ran in 2006 and 2007 when they won so many races with Mark Martin and Travis Kvapil. We have all the elements in place for a strong run, we just have to stay focused and be there at the end."

Crew chief Mike Beam on racing at Kansas Speedway:

"Colin had a great run in Kansas last year and earned a top-five finish so I'm counting on doing that, or better, this weekend. Kansas is a good track for Roush drivers, especially in the truck series. We spent two days testing at Rockingham last week to prepare and I think our efforts will pay off at the upcoming intermediate tracks. This should be a good weekend for us to gain back some points we lost in the last three races."

FAST FACTS:

-Braun will be racing chassis RK-43 at Kansas. This is the same truck he raced at California in February. Transmission trouble left him with at 20th-place finish there.



-Kansas Speedway is where Braun earned his best career truck finish last season with a third-place finish. Roush Fenway has three truck victories at Kansas - Jon Wood (2003), Carl Edwards (2004) and Erik Darnell (2007). It was the first career victory for Wood & Darnell.

-Although 21st in points, Braun ranks closer to the top 10 in almost every key statistical category. He has a driver rating of 80.3 (11th-best), an average running position of 13.8 (11th), a 14th-fastest green flag speed and a laps in the top 15 percentage of 58.3.
