Braun on racing at Texas Motor Speedway:

“I love racing at Texas. It’s such a fun track and we’ve had some pretty good results there. We got a third-place finish in our first trip there this year, so this time I really want to get the win. I consider this my home track since I’m from near Abilene, Texas. Our truck this weekend has been strong for us all year and won at Michigan in June. With only three races left this season I really want to get another win and Texas would be the best place I can think of to do it.”

Crew chief Mike Beam on racing at Texas Motor Speedway:

“We didn’t get the finish we wanted at Talladega, but we did what we needed to do in the points. Colin led the most laps and made it out in one piece which moved us up to fifth. We had a strong run in Texas in June and we’re taking our favorite intermediate truck this weekend. I know it would mean a lot to Colin to win in his home state, and this team would certainly like to get another win before the season is over.”

FAST FACTS:

-Braun will be racing chassis RK-43 at Texas. This is the same truck that won at Michigan in June and most recently raced at Las Vegas in September.

-Braun is currently fifth in the points with one win, seven top fives and 12 top 10-finishes. He also has four poles which ties Ron Hornaday for the most this season.

-Although fifth in points, Braun ranks in the top four in almost every key statistical category. He has a driver rating of 96.6 (fourth-best), an average running position of 8.9 (fourth-best) and third of drivers in laps in the top 15 with a percentage of 87.2 (3117 laps).

-Braun has two top-five finishes at Texas in only three starts there. Braun considers Texas his home track since he grew up in Ovalo (located near Abilene).
