Notes and Quotes

Biffle on Darlington: “Darlington is the hardest place we race. We run inches off the wall at speeds we run at mile and a half track. Any second it'll reach out and bite you and that's why they call it the Lady in Black. It is also very hard to pass to pass there which obviously adds another challenge. We've been able to have some success there with a couple of wins though so I always have high expectations when we go to Darlington.”

Erwin on Darlington: “I really like racing at Darlington, in fact, I would like to get a win there more than just about any other track. I grew up in Pennsylvania but I went to college at Clemson so I spent quite a bit of time in South Carolina. Darlington has a lot of history and it would just be incredible to win there. Greg has a couple of wins there but his last one was just a couple of weeks before I took this job in 2006. We had a great run there last year and led 95 laps before an engine failure took us out of contention. It's a handling track and you have to try to get the car to handle well at both ends which are completely different. One end of the track is much narrower than the other so it is nearly impossible to get your car to handle perfectly in both. I know it's one of Greg's favorite tracks and we'd both like to get the 3M Ford in victory lane there this weekend.”

Notes

- Biffle finished 17th in Richmond last week and is now 11th in the point standings.
- In last year's race at Darlington Biffle led 95 laps and was not seen outside of the top three other than during green flag pit cycles until an engine failure on lap 234 took him of the race.
