Track Notes

- In three starts this season, Darnell has two top-10 finishes including a fourth-place at Darlington.
- Darnell's best finish at Kentucky while in the Camping World Truck Series came in July 2006 when he finished ninth.
- This will be Darnell's first Nationwide Series race at Kentucky Speedway.
- Darnell picked up a win in his only ARCA Re/Max start at the speedway in 2007.

Erik Darnell on racing at Kentucky Speedway:

"I'm hoping to have some better luck this time around at Kentucky. My last two truck races ended with some pretty bad finishes. Minus last year, we qualified the truck just out of the top five twice in the three years we visited the cookie-cutter track. It's after that where things went bad for us. I'm excited for this weekend's race. We've had some good runs so far this season. I think we have the car this week that can keep us up front and hopefully contend for a win."

Crew Chief Mike Kelley on racing at Kentucky Speedway:

"Kentucky is a track that reminds me a lot of Charlotte, but a little flatter. It was a no brainer then to bring chassis 277 to Kentucky; the one David Ragan drove a few weeks back at Charlotte. David ran really well in it and I know Erik will do the same. This is the type of track that Erik tends to run well at, but you wouldn't tell by looking at the results the last couple of years. He has shown a lot of promise so far this season and I expect for that to continue this weekend."
