Notes and Quotes

Biffle on Chicago: "I love racing at mile-and-a-half tracks and I really like Saturday night races. We had a good car there last year but we just had a little trouble on pit road because we were missing one of our regular guys. You have to have a good aero package there and track position is crucial. You need to qualify well and not have any mistakes on pit road to compete for a win there. If we can do that and run as well as we did there last year, I think you'll see the 3M Ford Fusion up front."

Erwin on Chicago: "We had a good race and a fast car at Chicago last year but we struggled a little on pit road. We went for two tires at the end to regain track position and held on for fourth. I feel that we had a really good car. When we go back this year it will be with the same tire which will be nice. We had a Roush Fenway car at the tire test a few weeks ago and feel that we had a good baseline setup in the race last year so we'll start with those notes. It's a night race and both practices are in the afternoon so there will be some guessing. It's another cookie cutter track and fortunately that seems to be our strength."

Notes
• Biffle is 9th in the point standings following an 18th place finish at Daytona.

• In last year's race at Chicagoland, Biffle led 43 laps before dropping back a little with an ill-handling racecar. He was able to get back into the top five with pit strategy and remained there for a fourth place finish.

• Prior to coming to Chicago for the race this weekend, Biffle spent some time at 3M headquarters in St. Paul, Minnesota and did an appearance at Elko Speedway, a local Minnesota short track.

• Ryan Dextraze who has catchcan duty on raceday is being temporarily replaced by Bobby Grant. Dextraze will be out due to knee surgery for several weeks. Grant will be his replacement for the duration of his absence.
