Track Notes

- Darnell picked up his first career Camping World Truck Series victory at Kansas Speedway in 2007 leading a race high 92 laps.
- In 24 career starts on 1.5 mile tracks while in the Camping World Truck Series, Darnell has six top-five and 11 top-10 finishes with 187 laps led.
- Darnell will be doing double duty this weekend with Northern Tool + Equipment also the primary sponsor on the No. 96 Yates Racing Ford Fusion in Sunday's Cup race.
- In 12 races this season, Darnell has accumulated one pole, two top-five and five top-10 finishes with an average start position of 13.6 and average finish position of 12.8.

Erik Darnell on racing at Kansas Speedway:

"Kansas is a little bit different than a Charlotte or a Texas because it's a lot flatter. There seems to be quite a bit of racing room though and that makes it fun as a driver because you have some room to move around with your car. If we have a good setup this weekend, I think we got a good chance of contending Saturday afternoon. Kansas is a pretty easy track to get around. If we can get the car to turn well in the center and get back to the gas we should have a great run. There are quite a few folks from Northern Tool that will be at the race on Saturday and it would be really special to get the No. 6 car into victory lane."

Crew Chief Mike Kelley on racing at Kansas Speedway:

"I'm hoping for a good run this weekend for our No. 6 Northern Tool + Equipment Ford Fusion. Erik will be driving the same chassis that David [Ragan] drove at Texas with back in the spring when he picked up a fourth-place finish. Because of its size, having great track position throughout the race will be a major factor in how we end up finishing. We have the car, the pit crew and the driver to compete for the win this weekend; we just need to execute. If everybody does their job on Saturday, I think we've got a shot."
