- Ragan has two starts at Homestead-Miami Speedway. His best finish came in his first start in 2008; he qualified seventh and finished 10th.
- Ragan has an average starting position of 6.5 and finishing position of 17 at Homestead.
- Ragan will be running the new FR9 engine in Homestead. It will be the second time the team has run the new engine, the other was Talladega.
- Ragan has competed three times in the Nationwide Series at Homestead-Miami Speedway. In 2007 he claimed the pole position, but was caught up in an accident. His best finish came in 2008 where he finished 23rd.
