FAST FACTS

- Ragan has visited New Hampshire Motor Speedway four times; his best finish came in his first start at the track in the summer of 2007 where he finished 15th.
- Ragan has competed two times in the Nationwide Series at Loudon. His best finish came in the spring of 2008 where he qualified 22nd and finished sixth.
- Ragan has two Camping World Truck Series starts at Loudon. His best finish came in 2006 where he qualified 25th and finished 11th.
